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KBS Library has created Urkund account for all faculties & shared all the details with faculty members. The faculty members, who have not yet activated their account, can contact the Librarian, to get their account registered with the URKUND.

### **How the URKUND works?**

**STUDENTS** - Students send their documents for plagiarism check via e-mail, to their teachers/professors.

**URKUND** - When the documents arrive at URKUND, they are analyzed against the content of three source areas: the Internet, Published Material and Student Material. When the analyses are finished, the documents and generated reports are forwarded to the teachers.

**PROFESSORS** - The result of the analyses and the student documents are forwarded to the faculty member's e-mail address of choice, URKUND provides easy, straight-forward plagiarism prevention with minimum workload.
